Check out the FACTS:

GREAT FOR WALL STREET – NOT GREAT FOR US

- Jail construction is the "tip of the iceberg": \$210,000 per bed, \$858 per square foot. Contractors aren't paid that much – what's going on?
- Millions from this state money actually goes to Wall Street - for a "Lease-Revenue Bond" scheme – and the "revenue" is actually our tax dollars!
- County matching fund scheme drains millions from seven reserve funds – sabotaging finances
- The sales tax increase covers another part of the match by taking on even more high interest debt
- Promises to use the money for the jail (and sunset the tax later) are not in fact legally enforceable

IT'S TOO BIG

- Plans triple the number of inmates as county population declines; we need a right-sized jail instead
- 4/5 of people in jail now have not been sentenced – ankle bracelets can save food and housing costs
- State crime and sentencing trends are changing – we'll be stuck with a big white elephant
- The massive facility doesn't replace the current jail – they're keeping that too, with no solid plans for it
- There's no money to feed and guard new prisoners – what county services you use, will you lose?

KEEPS US BROKE, NOT SAFE

- We need officers off the highway, and into our communities
- Let's invest in our economy, not dubious schemes to increase taxes and fund overspending
- We can stop crime with common sense – dealing with mental illness and addiction through strong intervention and incentives, one person at a time – creating jobs and cost effective solutions
